



PRAGUE YOUTH RUGBY FESTIVAL – SPRING 2023 AGE GROUP U12 – SCHEDULE



Rugby success!

In the attachment, I am sending the draw for the basic (qualifying) part at the PYRF U12 in Petrovice on April 1, 2023.

30 teams are divided into six groups of five, in which they play each other, the playing time of the match is 1 x 7 minutes.

Groups A and D play on pitch A closest to the clubhouse, groups B and E play on pitch B in the other half of the pitch further from the clubhouse, groups C and F play on a designated pitch behind the main pitch.

After playing the basic part, the final part follows. the system is such that the top two teams from groups A, B and C form a six-man CUP 1 final group and play each other, but with the fact that the matches from the base group are no longer repeated and the result counts towards the final group, similarly so the top two teams from groups D, E and F will play the final group of CUP 2. So 12 teams will play the final stage for 1st - 12th place. Similarly, the third and fourth teams from base groups A, B and C form PLATE 1 and the third and fourth from base groups D, E and F form PLATE 2. These teams thus play for the 13th-24th place in these groups. All five of the basic groups will then form the BOWL group on the 25th-30th. place.

And at the very end, the runners-up from the final groups CUP 1 and CUP 2 play together for the overall third place and the winners of the final groups CUP 1 CUP 2 play together in the final for the overall victory. The other teams from the CUP and PLATE groups no longer play for the ranking and the better balance in their group is decided. For example, in the third place from groups CUP 1 and CUP 2, the balance of everyone in their group will be compared and the one with a better score will take 5th place and the one with a worse score will take 6th place and so on.

In case of equality of points, the ranking in the groups is decided in the following order:

- a. Larger difference of laid fives from all matches of the group (in the case of a negative difference, of course smaller)
- b. More layups from all matches in the group
- c. Head-to-head match
- d. Smaller number in the group of banned players
- e. Larger ratio on roster of listed players younger year (ie 2012)
- f. Moose

3 points are awarded for a win, 2 points for a draw and 1 point for a loss. If the team does not participate in the match, the participating team will receive 3 points and a score of 5:0, the offending team will not receive any points and will be assigned a score of 0:5.

All matches are played according to the approved modifications of the ČSRU rules for the category U12 spring version. Only players born in 2011 and 2012 may compete in the tournament. Girls born in 2010 can compete exceptionally in terms of ČSRU regulations.

The matches will be refereed by the Czech Republic - HR Raymond Burnard, AR Adam Petrášek + MINI Rugby referee + one DRV referee

Tournament program Saturday 1/4/2023

8:00 a.m. opening of the RK Petrovice area

8:50 a.m. welcome drink for coaches of foreign teams in the RK Petrovice clubhouse

9.05 a.m. meeting of organizers, referees and team coaches (compulsory for foreign teams, optional for domestic teams) in the meeting room on the 1st floor of the clubhouse, explanation of the rules

9.30 – 12.50 a.m. matches in the qualifying groups (the number of teams is really on the edge, so I ask everyone to watch their times and be at the matches on the right pitches on time, preferably ahead of time)

12.00 – 1.40 pm lunch break, depending on how individual teams finish the basic part

1:40 p.m. – 5:10 p.m. matches in the CUP, PLATE and BOWL final groups

5:20 p.m. – match for 3rd place and final match

5:45 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. – final award ceremony for all players, presentation of prizes to the first three teams of the tournament, presentation of the fair play award, end of the tournament.

Technical measures:

- In the area of RK Petrovice, all engineering networks have not been completed yet, so you cannot park in the area, not even on a limited basis, do not enter Grammova street at all, please inform all parents of the teams from OPČ
- Parking is also limited at the Newtonova public transport stop, as work is underway on the reconstruction of the Hostivařské dam, use the parking lot in Morseova street or the large-capacity parking lot in Dopplerova street (also suitable for buses)
- Foreign teams will have assigned changing rooms in the clubhouse (4 changing rooms for 12 teams), tents will be prepared for Moravian and non-Prague teams, teams from Prague and the surrounding area can bring and set up their own tent in agreement with the grounds manager Vašek Prokeš
